RENUNCIATION of BELIZEAN CITIZENSHIP CHECKLIST

English is the official language of Belize and all documents submitted must either be in English or be accompanied by a certified English translation of the whole document by a competent issuing authority.

• Correction liquid scratched or superimposed text on application forms are <u>not</u> acceptable.

1. COMPLETE APPLICATION FORM AND GATHER SUPPORTING	
DOCUMENTATION	
 Documents Required: A. Declaration Form renouncing Belizean Citizenship and stating the reason for doing so. 	
B. 3 originals of Form E <u>available upon request</u> from the Belize High Commission. Each original to be signed by the applicant in the presence of a Justice of the Peace, Attorney at Law, Notary Public or Solicitor.	
C. Birth certificate if the applicant was born in Belize, or original Belize Nationality Certificate in the case of a naturalized citizen,	
 D. 3 Identical Passport Photos - (2inches x 2inches) One photo must be <u>certified, signed and sealed</u> by a Justice of the Peace, Attorney at Law, Notary Public or Solicitor with the words, "I certify that this photo is the true likeness/image of "name of applicant." Two photos must be left blank on the back. 	
 E. All official Belizean identification cards including: Belize Passport Voters Identification Social Security card 	
2. MAKE PAYMENT	
Payment can be made by bank transfer in Pound Sterling (£) only – (See fees and payment instructions on website)	
 Include a copy of your bank's payment reference with the application. To ensure tracking and verification of the payment the following must be included with the payment reference: Applicant's name 	
\circ Name of the person making the bank transfer	
 Date of payment and any bank reference numbers 	
Please note that when applying at Foreign Missions, fees are higher than when applying in Belize.	
3. SUBMIT ORIGINAL APPLICATION AND ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATIO	
A copy of the application including all the required documents listed above now be submitted to the Belize High Commission	:an

 Your application will be forwarded to the Department of Immigration and Nationality in Belize for final processing. This process may take 4 to 6 months for processing. Each application must be submitted separately.
4. COLLECTION OF DOCUMENTS
 • Upon confirmation that your application has been processed, you will be advised to collect your renunciation certificate. This can be done, in person, by post or by courier.
